Evidence for Cannabis as Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use evidence-informed and anecdotal information to ascertain when cannabis and cannabinoid use may be appropriate for older patients
Pharmaceutical Cannabinoids, Modes of cannabis use, Dosing and Accessing Cannabis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognize the Indications, Dosing, Contraindications, Precautions, Drug Interactions and Adverse effects of pharmaceutical cannabinoids Identify cannabis modes of use most appropriate for older adults Apply the LIVE approach to cannabis dosing and titration Advise older adult patients on how to access cannabis
Adverse Effects & Special Considerations for Safety Safer Cannabis Use, Harm Reduction and Cannabis Use Disorder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify potential short and long term adverse effects of cannabis use Consider special considerations regarding safety of cannabis use dependant on your older patient's lifestyle Recognize strategies for safer cannabis consumption for your older patients Describe the evidence supporting cannabis use for harm reduction Recognize the recommendation outlined in the Cannabis Use Disorder Guidelines
